Reviewer:

The current sample is restricted to employed women from a single region (Isfahan). To ensure broader applicability of findings, it's suggested to include a more diverse demographic spread across multiple regions. Additionally, provide a power analysis to justify the sample size in relation to the effect sizes expected based on prior literature. Conduct a supplementary analysis with a stratified sample or include additional data from different socioeconomic backgrounds and regions.

The linkage between sexual self-awareness, perfectionism, and sexual function could be further enriched by incorporating specific psychological theories (e.g., Cognitive Behavioral Theory or Self-Determination Theory) that explain these relationships. Redefine the theoretical framework, specifying hypothesized pathways and interactions between variables based on established psychological models.

The manuscript briefly mentions the use of simultaneous multiple regression but lacks depth in the description of diagnostic tests for assumptions (e.g., homoscedasticity, normality of residuals). Include detailed diagnostics of regression assumptions.

If assumptions are violated, discuss alternative statistical approaches such as transformation of variables or robust regression techniques.
