Reviewer:

The skewness and kurtosis values are provided, but it would be helpful to include a brief discussion on how these values support the normality assumption for the variables.



The correlation table presents significant relationships, but the narrative should also address any unexpected non-significant correlations. Discuss potential reasons and implications for these findings.

The justification for using path analysis could be strengthened by explaining its advantages over other analytical methods for this study's context. Why was path analysis chosen?

The reported model fit indices indicate a good fit, but it would be helpful to include a comparison to acceptable thresholds (e.g., RMSEA < 0.08, CFI > 0.90) to contextualize these results.

The discussion on resilience would benefit from integrating more recent literature on the topic. For instance, discuss how resilience as a dynamic process interacts with marital satisfaction in more depth.

The limitations section should address the potential impact of using self-report measures. Discuss how this might influence the results and any steps taken to mitigate these issues.

The practical implications for family counselors are mentioned briefly. Expanding on specific strategies or interventions that could be derived from these findings would enhance the practical relevance of the study.

The descriptive-correlational study design is mentioned, but it would be helpful to include a brief discussion on the limitations of this design, particularly regarding causality.

The literature review could be expanded to include more recent studies on marital satisfaction, cognitive emotion regulation, and resilience, ensuring the study is situated within the current research landscape.

More details on the administration of the questionnaires (e.g., online, in-person, duration) would provide a clearer understanding of the data collection process.
