

# Comparison of the Effectiveness of Mindfulness-Based Compassion Therapy and Positive Cognitive-Behavioral Therapy on Ambiguity Tolerance in Female Heads of Households

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## 1. Round 1

#### 1.1. Reviewer 1

Reviewer:

"Problems have always been unpleasant for humans and ambiguous situations especially those related to change have the potential to evoke destructive stress in individuals (Adamson 2018)." - This sentence could be more precise. "Results of Repeated Measures ANOVA for Ambiguity Tolerance in Pre-test Post-test and Follow-up" - Consider breaking down this table for clarity, as the current format is dense and may overwhelm the reader.

"These findings are consistent with previous studies on the impact of mindfulness-based compassion therapy on increasing ambiguity tolerance (Bibi et al. 2022; Papenfuss et al. 2022)." - Explain how the current study's findings specifically align with those of Bibi et al. (2022) and Papenfuss et al. (2022).

"Positive cognitive-behavioral therapy also had a statistically significant impact on increasing ambiguity tolerance in female heads of households." - Include a comparison to other studies or therapies, if available, to contextualize the effectiveness of positive cognitive-behavioral therapy.

### 1.2. Reviewer 2

"This protocol was first implemented by Kristen Neff and Christopher Germer in 2010 in Fritz Perls House in Big Sur on a group of 12 participants in 8 sessions of two hours and forty-five minutes." - Provide a reference or more details on the initial implementation to support this statement.

"The results of the repeated measures ANOVA for ambiguity tolerance are presented in Table 2." - Provide a brief interpretation of the key findings from Table 2 within the text to assist reader comprehension.

"This study examined the effectiveness of mindfulness-based compassion therapy and positive cognitive-behavioral therapy on ambiguity tolerance in female heads of households in Shahrekord..." - Discuss potential reasons why mindfulness-based compassion therapy was more effective than positive cognitive-behavioral therapy.

"The study was quasi-experimental; therefore some confounding variables... were uncontrollable." - List specific examples of these confounding variables to enhance transparency and credibility.

"The results indicate that the mean difference between pre-test and post-test (intervention effect) and between pre-test and follow-up (time effect) are significant..." - Provide a clearer explanation of what 'intervention effect' and 'time effect' entail in the context of your study.
