1.1. Reviewer 1

Reviewer:

The statement "The family is a social and cultural system that alongside all its characteristics has rules and roles serving as a refuge for meeting psychological and emotional needs" can be supported by more recent references. Consider citing recent studies to strengthen this argument.

Add more recent studies in the literature review to update the context, especially those from the past five years to ensure the relevance of the research.

In "The sample consisted of 45 women...", provide more details about the recruitment process and any incentives provided to participants.

The quasi-experimental design is appropriate, but explain why this design was chosen over other experimental designs.

Clarify the use of repeated measures ANOVA and why it was selected as the appropriate statistical test for this study.

1.2. Reviewer 2

Reviewer:

Provide a clearer definition of "marital burnout" and its distinction from related constructs such as "marital distress" and "marital dissatisfaction".

When mentioning the prevalence of marital burnout, "Family experts' research indicates that the prevalence of marital burnout is more significant today than in the past with 20% of couples experiencing it at any time", include specific references to support this claim.

The text states "The Shapiro-Wilk test results for checking the normality of data distribution showed that the null hypothesis of normal distribution of scores in the research variables remained in all three stages". This could be more clearly stated as "The data met the assumption of normality as indicated by non-significant Shapiro-Wilk test results (p > 0.05)".

The discussion on the greater effectiveness of R-DBT could benefit from a deeper exploration of potential mechanisms behind the observed differences. Consider discussing how the integration of resilience components may uniquely contribute to treatment outcomes.

The comparison of the study's findings with previous research should be expanded. Currently, it is stated broadly. Specific studies and their findings should be detailed to provide a stronger comparison.

While the study's limitation regarding its sample being from one city is noted, also discuss other potential limitations such as the lack of blinding and its impact on the results.
