1.1. Reviewer 1

Reviewer:

Quote: "The results indicated that the Parental Stress Index had a negative relationship with democratic parenting..."

1.2. Reviewer 2

Reviewer:

Comment: The definition of democratic parenting could benefit from more detail regarding its theoretical framework. How does it differ from other parenting styles in terms of measurable outcomes?

Quote: "Among the different styles—neglectful (permissive), authoritarian, and democratic (authoritative)—democratic parents exhibit more warmth..."

Comment: Clarify why "neglectful" is grouped with "permissive." These are often treated as distinct styles in parenting literature. Consider refining these distinctions.

Quote: "Wisdom enables parents to overlook certain childish behaviors and focus on appropriate conduct..."

Comment: The relationship between wisdom and parenting could be better grounded in empirical evidence. Provide citations that establish wisdom as a key construct in parenting studies.

Quote: "The sampling method was random cluster sampling."

Comment: Elaborate on why cluster sampling was chosen over other methods and how it minimizes bias in a population as large and diverse as Tehran.
