1.1. Reviewer 1

Reviewer:

"The theoretical foundations and cited findings highlight the critical role of third-wave therapies..."

This statement introduces third-wave therapies but does not elaborate on their relevance to marital burnout. Adding a brief overview of why these therapies are particularly suited to address marital issues would strengthen the introduction.

"The results indicated significant differences between the two experimental groups..."

Include specific statistical values (e.g., effect sizes or p-values) to provide evidence for the claim of significant differences.

Reviewer:

The explanation of burnout is detailed, but it would benefit from specific examples or a brief discussion of measurable criteria to assess these forms of exhaustion in research.

"Dissatisfied couples tend to engage in more maladaptive interactions and behaviors..."

This generalization could be supported by additional citations or examples to clarify how maladaptive interactions were measured or defined.

"Role-playing was employed in this study as a technique for various purposes..."

Expand on how role-playing specifically contributed to the outcomes in CBT. Were there observable differences in outcomes for participants who actively engaged in role-playing versus those who did not?
