

Reviewer:

The article provides a demographic breakdown of the sample population but does not sufficiently justify the criteria for participant selection. Expanding on why these particular individuals were chosen and how they contribute to achieving theoretical saturation would add depth to the research methodology.

The study would benefit from a more detailed explanation of the systemic approach and grounded theory in the context of public management and good governance. Linking the research methodology more explicitly to the theoretical underpinnings would provide a stronger foundation for the study.

The article could be enhanced by including diagrams or models that visually represent the findings or the proposed model for improving good governance. Visual aids can help readers better understand complex processes and relationships.

There are sections in the article that could benefit from technical editing for grammar, punctuation, and consistency in terminology. Ensuring that the article is free from typographical errors would improve its readability and professional quality.
