The methodology section states, "Sampling of cities in Gilan Province in this stage of the research is purposeful." Elaborate on why these specific cities were chosen and how they represent the broader population.

Provide more detail on the interview process. For example, "Interviews were conducted in person, ensuring a consistent approach with each participant." This adds transparency and reproducibility to the study.

Expand on the practical implications of your findings. How can poultry farmers in Gilan Province apply these insights to improve supply chain performance?

Address the limitation regarding generalizability more explicitly. For example, "Due to the regional focus on Gilan Province, the findings may not be generalizable to other areas with different environmental and economic conditions."
