

Reviewer:

"The sentence 'Despite the many benefits that ICT may bring...' could be expanded to discuss specific adverse effects and provide concrete examples from recent studies."

"In discussing the digital divide, it would be beneficial to include statistical data on the current state of digital inequality in different regions to enhance the argument."

"The assertion about socio-economic factors leading to asymmetry in technology use would benefit from additional references to contemporary research to validate these claims."

"The description of the research methodology should clarify the specific grounded theory approach used and any particular modifications or adaptations made for this study."

"The initial summary of findings could be more concise. Focus on the most significant results and their implications for educational justice."

"While the proposed model's benefits are well articulated, discussing potential limitations or challenges in implementation would provide a more balanced view."

"The recommendation for ensuring technological infrastructure should include practical steps or strategies that education administrators can follow to achieve this goal."
