The study design lacks a control group, which is crucial for validating the causal relationship between the counseling model and the observed outcomes. Consider adding a control group to enhance the study's rigor and validity.

To assess the long-term effectiveness of the counseling model, incorporate a longitudinal follow-up with the participants. This would provide data on the sustainability of the outcomes over time.

The method section should include a more detailed description of the statistical analyses conducted. This includes specifying the type of tests used to analyze the data, the rationale for their use, and the interpretation of the statistical results.

Integrate and discuss how the findings align or conflict with existing theoretical frameworks within family counseling and conflict resolution literature. This deeper theoretical integration would provide a more robust context for understanding the study's contributions.

The current sample appears limited to a specific demographic and geographic location. Expanding the participant pool to include diverse backgrounds could enhance the generalizability of the findings.
