1.2. Reviewer 2

Reviewer:

The problem statement could be more explicit. The sentence "Given the increasing incidence of sexual abuse and the negative impacts..." (paragraph 5) should clearly outline the specific gaps in the current literature that this study aims to address.

The description of the sampling method should include details on how purposive sampling was implemented. For example, explain the criteria used to select the 45 participants from the screened group (Methods and Materials section).

Clearly differentiate between the results of the ANCOVA and the Bonferroni post hoc tests. This will help readers understand which specific comparisons were made (Tables 2 and 3).

The discussion should delve deeper into the implications of the findings. For instance, the statement "This finding is consistent with the results of prior studies..." (Discussion section) should be followed by a critical analysis of how your results align or diverge from those studies.
