## 1.1. Reviewer 1

# Reviewer:

#### Reviewer:

"For instance, although individual differences exist, people generally believe their lives are predictable, orderly, and meaningful..." - This statement needs more support from empirical studies. Adding references to recent research will strengthen the argument.

"Cronbach's alpha coefficients for Conflict Creation, Conflict Expression, Conflict Confrontation, Conflict Engagement, and Solution Attainment and Integration being 0.83, 0.66, 0.71, 0.79, and 0.80 respectively..." - The alpha coefficient for Conflict Expression is relatively low. Discuss potential reasons and implications for this.

"The present study aimed to construct and examine the psychometric properties of the Meaning Formation Scale in adolescents." - Consider comparing your findings with similar studies or scales to highlight the unique contributions of your research.

"The first factor identified was Conflict Creation..." - Provide more context on how this factor relates to existing theories of meaning formation and adolescent development.

"The third factor identified was Conflict Confrontation..." - Discuss how this factor may manifest differently in various adolescent populations (e.g., cultural differences).
